Committee Welcome: Larry Powell, Committee Chair Mr. Powell welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Point of Contact Status Update: Maxcine Maxted, DOE-SR Ms. Maxted updated the Committee on each Nuclear Materials program project.

Presentation: <u>Plutonium: K-Area Status Update and Downblending Status</u>: Allen Gunter, DOE-SR

Mr. Gunter began the presentation with a historical perspective of the plutonium stabilization and packaging program. He reviewed the plutonium flow path, the storage areas, 3013 containers and 9975 shipping containers, the surveillance program, shelf-life testing, destructive examinations, and the surveillance results. Mr. Gunter reviewed the status of downblending non-moxable plutonium.

Mr. Gunter responded to questions from Committee members and the public. Receipt of plutonium from Japan was a focal point of the discussion.

Committee Discussion

Draft Recommendation: "Improving H Canyon Throughput" The Committee ran out of time to discuss this draft recommendation.

Draft Position Statement: "Interim or Long Term Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel and High Level Waste"

David Hoel, CAB Member, noted that the position statement has been open for a number of years and was up for renewal. Mr. Hoel presented edits that he had made in anticipation of renewal. The question before the Committee was whether to renew as is or renew with updates. Mr. Hoel read the updated portions of the position paper.

The ensuing discussion focused on specific language within the position statement and timing of presentation to the full board.

The Committee agreed that the original position statement should expire and an updated statement presented to the full board for voting.

Draft Position Statement: "Proposed Acceptance and Disposition of Spent Nuclear Fuel (SNF) Containing US-Origin Highly Enriched Uranium from the Federal Republic of Germany"

The Committee ran out of time to discuss this draft recommendation.

Public Comment

Rose Hayes, Public, commented on the use of the term "repository."

Elaine Cooper, the John Bachman Sierra Club, commented on the CAB Position Statement on the "Proposed Acceptance and Disposition of Spent Nuclear Fuel (SNF) Containing US-Origin Highly Enriched Uranium from the Federal Republic of Germany." Written statement entered into the minutes.

Jeff Allender, Public, commented on the public meeting in North Augusta, SC, in February 2016 regarding long-term storage.

Mr. Wilkins Byrd, Conservation Voters of South Carolina, commented on the German SNF.

Suzanne Rhodes, SC League of Women Voters, submitted a written statement on the German SNF.

The Committee discussed the requirements to set up a special meeting in July to discuss pending Recommendations.

Mr. Powell adjourned the meeting.
