Nuclear Materials (NM) Committee Meeting

The NM Committee held a meeting on Tuesday, April 12, 2016, from 4:30 – 6:20 pm, at the New Ellenton Community Center, New Ellenton, SC. The purpose of this meeting was to receive a Point of Contact status update and a presentation on the 2-Year Look Roadmap. There was also time set aside for committee discussion and public comments.

Point of Contact Status Update: Maxcine Maxted, DOE-SR
Ms. Maxted reviewed the status of each Nuclear Materials program project.

Presentation: 2-Year Look Roadmap: Jay Ray, DOE-SR
Mr. Ray reviewed all of the Nuclear Material Facilities on-site at SRS. His review included historical data and assumptions, cross-site interfaces, deactivated and inactive facilities, and the two-year Nuclear Materials planning roadmap for 2016 and 2017.

Dawn Gillas, Committee Vice-Chair, requested clarification on oxide purity and mixes, and received a satisfactory response.

Susan Corbett, Committee Member, asked how sodium reactor fuel was processed and about the testing of the containers for long-term storage. Mr. Ray, along with Pat McGuire, DOE-SR, reiterated the testing variables and outcomes and the path forward for surveillance and monitoring.
