Point of Contact Status Update: Soni Blanco, DOE-SR

Soni Blanco presented an update on tank closures, DWPF and SWPF. Sludge waste removal is continuing at Tank 15. SRR has award a contract to Westinghouse Electric Company to design and fabricate an ion exchange process with tank deployment for the removal of cesium. Crossbars have been removed for the double stacking process and new support plates have also been installed. 50 radioactive canisters have been stacked. Cell construction of SDU-6 has been completed and installation of a liner has begun and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

Ms. Blanco concluded her update by answering questions from the Committee.

Presentation: Tank Closure Program Update: Jolene Seitz, DOE-SR; Steven Thomas, SRR

The presentation explained and reviewed tank closure status and the phases of activities after waste removal. Tank 15's bulk execution has begun but no waste has been removed yet. Ms. Seitz also provided an update of the older style tanks. Mr. Thomas explained the technology behind the Tank Closure Cesium Removal (TCCR). The focus area this year is to finalize the interim RCRA/CERCLA documents needed for H-Tank Farm. Tank 12 will continue performing its BWRE campaigns. Ms. Seitz reviewed the dispute with the state and EPA.

Mr. Thomas and Ms. Seitz concluded the presentation by answering questions from the Committee and public.

The Committee discussed topics and ideas for future presentations and commented on Site activities and projects.
