Point of Contact Status Update: Jeff Bentley, DOE-SR Mr. Bentley updated the Point of Contact status for each project and answered several questions from the CAB.

Presentation: <u>Liquid Waste System Overview</u>: Peter Hill, SRR Mr. Hill presented an end-to-end overview of the Liquid Waste System.
