Committee Purpose

The committee deals with issues related to the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), risk management/assessment, the regulatory process, and other cross-cutting issues pertaining to environmental restoration. The committee also follows deactivation and decommissioning (D&D) actions taken to reduce risk and costs following shutdown of excess industrial, radioactive, and nuclear facilities.
