Mr. Allensworth welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Committee Discussion

The Committee commented and discussed the status of their open and pending recommendations, Rec. 336: Waste Management Milestones, Rec. 339: Liquid Waste Revision 20 and Rec. 340: Commend the Originators of the Double-Stacking Idea. The Committee decided to keep Rec. 336 Open until further information is provided. The Committee motioned and agreed to close Rec. 336 at the next Full Board. David Hoel, CAB Member, stated that at the March Full Board meeting the originators of the double stacking idea for commended and recognized for their efforts and he moved to close Rec. 339 and the Committee agreed.

The Committee discussed presentations from the March Full Board meeting, DWPF Melter Change Out and Recent Liquid Waste Regulatory Decisions. Wes Bryan, SRR and Jim Folk, DOE answered questions from the public and the Committee regarding melter life, new melter, melter schedule and logistics and updates on the liquid waste program.

Jolene Seitz, DOE-SR commented on the dispute resolution and informed the CAB and public of the upcoming meetings.

Point of Contact Status Update: Jim Folk, DOE-SR

Jim Folk informed the CAB and public that the liquid waste melter change out effort is focused on melter change out and SWPF preparation for integration.

Joe Ortaldo, Public, suggested having DOE present a tutorial about waste to the Board to explain waste classification.

Bill Lawless, Public, asked the CAB to consider the idea of reclassifying the waste in the High-Level waste canisters.
