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# **Savannah River Site Transition Planning Memorandum**

As DOE-Environmental Management (EM) completes its cleanup work at SRS toward a defined end-state of 2065, the National Nuclear Security Administration's (NNSA) nuclear security mission continues to increase onsite.

As a result, EM is transferring stewardship responsibilities to NNSA

A working Transition Plan addresses the direction and represents a joint agreement between EM and NNSA to accomplish a seamless SRS transition with fairness and continuity for ongoing programs.

- Letter issued October 6, 2022, from EM-1 and NA-1
- Transfers overall responsibility of SRS from EM to NNSA by FY25 (October 1, 2024)



# **SRS Transition Plan**

#### Transfers Four (4) Major Responsibilities from EM to NNSA:



U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY



- Accounts for responsibility and management of functions transferring from EM to NNSA
- Provides an integrated detailed Plan of Actions and Milestones
- Supports NNSA assumption of primary Site management responsibility & budget authority by functions in Fiscal Year 2025
- EM will remain focused on completing important remaining legacy cleanup activities at SRS.
