High Level Waste Tank Use

Based on our review of the Environmental Remediation (ER) plans for the Old F-Area Seepage Basin, the SRS Citizens Advisory Board recommends that the Department of Energy, Savannah River Site:

- Assess the feasibility of using the retired HLW tanks for the disposal of contaminated soil removed from ER surface units (e.g., the Old F-Area Seepage Basin contaminated soils). This approach for HLW tank closure and for ER soil remediation has the potential to be more effective than independent actions in either program.
- Evaluate the ER Program so that those sites on the list agreed to by the three agencies (SCDHEC, EPA, and DOE-SR) with the highest risks be remediated first; further, for sites preparing to be remediated, explore ways to shorten the implementation of remediation, especially the design phase.
- 3. Include both item 1 and 2 above in the Strategy Section of SRS's ER Management Action Plan.
