SUBJECT: Removal of High Level Waste from the Savannah River Site (SRS) to the Permanent Federal Repository

TO: Mr. Dan Dreyfus, Director, Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management

The Savannah River Site Citizens Advisory Board (SRS CAB) submitted a recommendation regarding the removal of high level waste from the SRS to a permanent federal repository.
