Thank you for your November 18, 2003, letter concerning the Savannah River Site Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) Recommendation 175. In that recommendation, you request the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) continue to work with the Department of Energy, Savannah River Site (DOE-SR) and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) to set clear boundaries for expanding the use of Monitored Natural Attenuation/Enhanced Passive Remediation (MNA/EPR) at appropriate SRS contaminated sites.

EPA promotes the investigation of this and other innovative processes to optimize performance and to ensure that the attenuation process will operate for extended periods. EPA continues to participate in national working groups on this subject and will continue to work closely with DOE-SR and SCDHEC to develop a protocol for the use of MNA/EPR at the site.
