## SUBJECT: Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) Recommendation Number 181 – High Level Waste (HLW) Tank Longevity Versus Expected Lifetime (Your letter, 01/28/04)

Thank you for your Recommendation regarding HLW Tank Longevity versus Expected Lifetime. We appreciate your support in desiring tangible, near-time progress toward HLW disposition and tank closure. The U.S. Department of Energy Savannah River Operations Office (DOE-SR) will update you on our understanding of the issues surrounding waste removal from the HLW Tanks by May 24, 2004.

DOE is working with the State of South Carolina to resolve issues regarding the Waste Incidental to Reprocessing process. Disposal limits for salt waste cannot be established until these issues are resolved. By May 24, 2004, DOE will update you on the status of these efforts.

DOE agrees that tank closure activities should be pursued expeditiously and is working to establish a path forward. DOE will brief you by July 26, 2004, on the progress of these activities.
