The Department concurs that the DOE should address issues which would affect the health and safety of the public, workers, and the environment, and that they have a responsibility to assure this. The Department views compliance with the Federal Facilities Agreement, permits, and other agreements as the mechanism to achieve this goal. The Department maintains it's position of renegotiating commitments based on funding shortfalls only when DOE demonstrates that they did not receive the appropriate funding form Congress. Finally, we concur that finding efficiencies and additional funding should be fully explored and will continue working with DOE and EPA to explore ways to reduce costs.
