
SUBJECT: Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) Recommendation Number 80 – Miscellaneous
Chemical Basin/Metals Burning Pit

Thank you for submitting the subject recommendation regarding support for the planned
remedial action at the Miscellaneous Chemical Basin and Metals Burning Pit.

The Savannah River Site is expeditiously proceeding with the proposed remedial action.
Additionally, the criteria for determining changes in phases of vadose remediation will be
specified in the post Record of Decision documents. The CAB will be briefed, as requested, on
these criteria in July. Upon completing the interim groundwater remedial action, documents
supporting a final decision for groundwater remediation will evaluate passive remedial
technologies. Such technologies will be implemented if deemed cost effective and protective of
human health and the environment.
