Currently we are to revise the Risk Summaries with the latest data as submitted by the field offices for the Paths to Closure. These will be published again this summer as "working documents." Following that publication, we will be piloting revised Risk Summaries which will incorporate changes in structure and content based on the many comments we have received from stakeholders across the country, including yours. The pilot Risk Summary will be sent out for stakeholder review as soon as it becomes available.

We will continue to work with you and DOE Savannah River Operations Office to develop a Risk Summary for Savannah River Site that will be a useful, important communication tool.
