## SUBJECT: Citizens Advisory Board (CAB) Recommendation Number 90 – Nuclear Materials Integration Project

Thank you for submitting the subject recommendation supporting the Department of Energy's (DOE) concept of an integrated effort to consolidate nuclear materials.

We support the concept and are actively working to support funding for the shipment of Americium and Curium from Savannah River to Oak Ridge, and this includes resolving cross-program funding issues. Recent changes in DOE Headquarters-field relationships, and establishment of a Field Management Council should improve cross-program planning. Consolidation of nuclear materials represents a large potential for cost savings across the DOE complex, and we are working these issues with a high priority.

As discussed at our meetings with the CAB, we are placing a strong emphasis on involving stakeholders at the earliest stages of DOE's deliberations concerning the management, stabilization, storage, and ultimate disposition of surplus nuclear materials. Likewise, as the specific topical reports mentioned in your letter become available, we will share the information in them with your committee.
